

Synopsis	The Access Control Ecosystem
<p>The smart home starts at the front door – smart door locks, video doorbells, and garage doors are access-control devices that are foundational to smart home growth. The front door also represents the access point for a future world of services. Companies are vying for ecosystem control of access points into the home that leverage home service opportunities. This report assesses the access control ecosystem, profiles key players, and evaluates the strategies toward home services.
